## What is a Junior Naturalist?

Junior Naturalists are volunteers that help our summer day camp team. They are leaders that make the camper's experience at Ney fun, exciting, and safe. Assisting with all aspects of camp including leading games, supervising campers during activities, and working with staff to ensure this is a fun and safe summer for everyone!

## What are the requirements?

- Volunteers must be going into 10-12th grade.

- Be a responsible, trustworthy, and dependable volunteer. Be able to take direction, feedback, and follow-through with assigned responsibilities while maintaining a mature, positive, service-oriented attitude.
- Complete an interview with Ney Staff, participate in mandatory training, commit to volunteering for at least 1 week of camp.

Make new friends and connections through staff and fellow volunteers. Build leadership skills and gain valuable, fun, hands-on experience working with children and nature. Volunteer time is eligible for service learning credits and is great for resume building.
